**Subject: MULTIPLE LOAD LINE ASSIGNMENT BOOK REVISION**

**Date: 23 July 2019**

Please be advised that with the revision of Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) Marine Notice [2-015-2](#), the RMI Multiple Load Line Assignment Book (Assignment Book) has also undergone revision. The revisions authorize the vessel Master to record the change of freeboard in the existing multiple load lines and endorse the Assignment Book without an attending Recognized Organization (RO) Surveyor. New Assignment Books will be issued following normal practice when the existing books expire.

In the interim, the Master may endorse the current Assignment Book on the "Surveyor" line. Although it is not necessary, should shipowners' representatives wish to obtain a new, updated Assignment Book, a written request may be made to [technical@register-iri.com](mailto:technical@register-iri.com). It will be provided at the normal cost for each vessel and have the same expiration date as the current booklet.

This Advisory is applicable to existing, multiple Load Line Certificates only. Any request for new, additional International Load Line Certificates should be made in the normal manner through the RO.

This MSA expires one (1) year after its issuance, unless otherwise noted, extended, superseded, or revoked.
